Low shrinkage

Builder Jezz Coleman is using the 1:48 Tamiya 'Dingo' Scout Car and Deluxe Materials Perfect Plastic Putty and Pin-Point Syringe Kit in this guide





You can use Perfect Plastic Putty for scratch or dent repairs. Just squeeze a thin line of putty form the tube



carefully spread the putty



Once dry, polish carefully with a fine grade



You can also apply the putty for extra fine work using the Pin-Point Syringe Kit



You can also use this method to create weld seams



Once again sand with very fine grade material



You can also colour Perfect Plastic Putty and use this for adding mud or spatter. Using a palette or similar, mix Perfect Plastic Putty with a small amount of water based paint until you get a smooth paste, and add this into the Syringe



The select a suitable tip, and apply to your model



Then simply blend, and add pigments until you have the desired effect
