

# Making Realistic Trees with Scenic Spray



The difference between a good layout and fabulous one is that the trees should appear as they do in the environment i.e. as in different sizes shades and shapes. In this article we show how the Scenic Spray glue is used with seafoam trees.

After purchasing a selection of seafoam trees prepare a cup of scatter in the colour you require. Then from a selection of trees Fig 1. take one at a time. Then spray the glue using the gentle pump spray action Fig 2. Make several passes to ensure all the branches are covered. (Clean up your hands before the glue dries with hot soapy water.)

Then before the glue dries pour the scatter over the seafoam tree and shake off any loose scatter Fig 3.

Then finally respray the tree with one last spray of Scenic Spray glue, as this will seal any loose scatter. Fig 4. This way no two trees will be alike. A finished tree is shown in Fig 5.

Mount the tree using a cocktail stick.

**Useful Tips:** You can straighten trees by soaking in dilute Speedbond glue and hanging upside down on a line to dry.

Seal down scatter elsewhere on the landscape simply by overspraying with Scenic Spray as shown in Fig 6.
