Deluxe Materials Track Magic pack contents: 50ml bottle of Track Magic, beaker, pipette, swab and brush.



Dirty track... Not good! It needs the Track Magic treatment.



Transfer Track Magic into the beaker.


Tip: Keep the bottle in a mug to avoid spillages.



Use the pipette to dispense about a millilitre of Track Magic onto the swab to moisten.



Rub swab lightly along the railhead.



The railhead is now clean.



At intervals the swab may need cleaning. To clean swab apply a little solvent and blot dry with clean tissue.
